## BRUSSELS SPROUTS GRONINGER

(*Brassica oleracea*) Groninger is an easy to grow- steady producing variety. These medium to small sprouts are an ideal choice for first timers. Sprouts form a tight head and maintain a delicate flavor even in variable weather. Groninger Brussels can handle a light frost and will improve in flavor with the cold weather. This variety has received the RHS Award of Garden Merit

### PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

Usually best as a fall crop. Start like broccoli, setting out 2 months before first frost in the fall. Rich soil is essential for lots of "sprouts," and flavor is improved by light frosts in the Autumn.

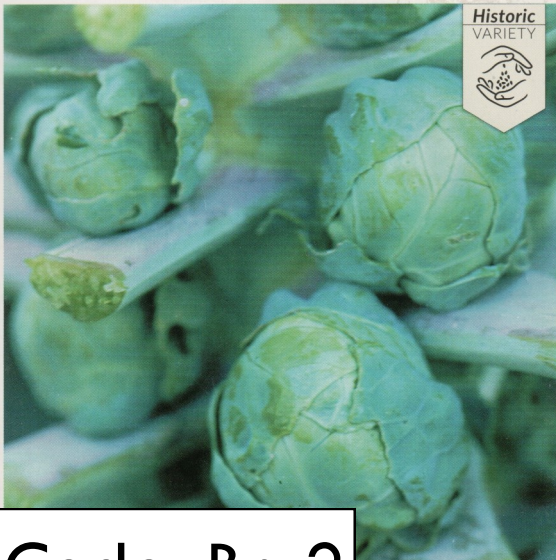

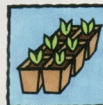

### 0913 - Long Island Improved (*Brassica oleracea*)

*Historic variety - Introduced to the US seed trade before 1950*

Introduced in the 1890s. Once the most important commercial sprout variety in the US. Compact 24" plants yield 50-100 dark green 1½" sprouts over an extended period. 80-115 days from transplant.



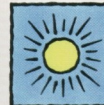
**Start Indoors**  
6-8 weeks  
before last frost



**Germination**  
5-10 Days



**Plant Outdoors**  
24" Apart



**Light**  
Full Sun

**Instructions-** Sow seeds indoors ¼" deep. Plant out just before the last frost. Brussels sprouts are a slow-growing, long-season vegetable that requires a regular supply of water. The sprouts are most delicious after frost.
